

# 12 HEREFORDSHIRE/GLOUCS SYMONDS YAT

Distance: 5½ miles/8.9km Time: 3 hours Grade: Moderate







CHOSEN BY LUCY RABONE The Wve Valley is renowned for the

spectacular views to be enioved from Yat Rock, where you can watch the Peregrine Falcons swooping in among the horseshoe loop of the River Wye. This walk starts in the less well-known side of Symonds Yat - in the West. Enjoy climbing up through the country lanes, going down the forest tracks. crossing the bridge, walking along the riverside footpaths and taking the hand ferry at the Saracen's Head Inn. This picturesque walk will ensure you have a chance to appreciate one of the best spots in the area!

# Start

From The Paddocks Hotel turn R onto the B4164 then immediately L onto Ashes Lane. Continue to the end. then turn Lonto Saw Pitts Lane and walk to the top.

1 mile/1.6km At the Saw Pitts Lane sign, turn sharply L onto the larger unnamed lane. After Green Meadow, vou'll see two footpaths on the R. take the L. hand path. Follow this and you'll pop out onto the lane again. Follow the lane past Beechnut Cottage, and fork R onto Marling Pits Lane, a small green path. Go straight ahead. with a white horse stable on your L and carry on. Turn R






The red chalet between the Royal Lodge and Yat Rock Viewpoint where Netflix's Sex Education was filmed (take a peek over the fence!).



go straight ahead onto May Bush Lane and follow this as it bends to the R and walk past Woodview. At the end turn L.

**2**½ miles/3.6km Walk down through Lord's Wood car park, going through the big green gate. Follow this main track down for a mile until you reach another big green gate at the warden's cabin. Turn R and cross Biblins Bridge.

31/4 miles/5.2km Turn L onto the Peregrine Path. Follow this along the



riverside for 1½ miles until vou reach the Royal Lodge. Just after here. turn R and walk up into the woods. At the red chalet fork R. walk up two sets of steps straight ahead, until you reach the café at the top.

5 miles/8km From here you can visit

Yat Rock viewpoint. Retrace vour steps back down to the Royal Lodge. Turn R and walk to The Saracen's Head Inn and take the hand ferry across
